Continued Participation in the Brevard County Law Enforcement MSTU (MSTU) with Financial Impact Information

Malabar approved the MSTU at 0.8680 mil per \$1000.00 of value; that millage increased annually to 1.35574 dropping to 1.3378 in 2013. The cost breakdown is: 2006 a house with a taxable value of \$85,000.00 paid \$73.75; 2012 the same house paid \$115.38. This excludes the county tax charged all property owners for the jail, canine, helicopter, SWAT services and court costs.
